When Bites Happen

If bitten by someone's dog when you were doing nothing to provoke it, Brad can help!

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), about 4.5 million people are bitten by a dog each year. Most dog bite victims are young children between ages 5 and 9 years old. Dog attacks can lead to severe physical and emotional damage, and one in five victims of dog bite attacks will require medical attention for their injuries.

Due to our state's leniency toward dogs and their owners when it's a first occurence, it is possible that the victim could sometimes be under scrutiny. In order to approach your case with the greatest chance of success, do not provide the dog's owner with any sort of apology or evidence of what occurred. You should also not accept any initial money offers without first consulting your lawyer.

In certain situations, you could be held at least partially accountable for your dog bite injury if you: Trespassed onto the dog owner's property; intentionally provoked the dog; caused injury to the dog, and it bit in retaliation; or ignored posted signs or warn-



ing behaviors. A minor dog bite could result in medical fees if stitches, shots or medication are required. Be sure you are not the one stuck paying out-of-pocket expenses. For more information on dog bites and your rights in Texas, go to parkerlawfirm.com.

Hot Cheesy Spinach Dip

- · 2 tbsp butter
- 1/4 cup chopped onion
- · 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 1 tbsp all-purpose flour
- 13/4 cups half-and-half
- 2 packages (9 ounces each) frozen chopped spinach, thawed, well drained
- 1 can (8 ounces) slices water chestnuts, drained
- 1 cup shredded cheddar cheese
- 1 package (1 ounce) dry vegetable soup mix
- 1/4 cup shredded Parmesan cheese
- 1. Preheat oven to 425 degrees. Melt butter in large saucepan over medium heat. Add onion and garlic; cook and stir until onion is crisp-tender and garlic is fragrant, 2-3 minutes.
- 2. Stir in flour; cook and stir an additional minute. Add half-and-half, stirring constantly until mixture boils and thickens, about 2 minutes.
- 3. Remove saucepan from heat. Stir in chopped spinach, water chestnuts, cheddar and vegetable soup mix. Spoon dip into a 1-quart casserole dish. Sprinkle with Parmesan.
- 4. Bake dip until bubbly, 10-15 minutes. Serve warm.
